The City of Chipley will be holding their municipal election August 1, 2017. This Voter's Guide has been prepared to inform you of what you can expect on Election Day.

\*\* You will be asked to provide a current and valid picture identification with a signature when you go to the polls. Acceptable forms of identification include:

- Florida driver's license
- Florida ID card issued by the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles
- United States Passport
- Debit or Credit Card
- Military Identification
- Student Identification
- Retirement Center Identification
- Neighborhood Association Identification
- Public Assistance Identification
- Veteran Health Identification Card
- Concealed Weapons License
- Employee Identification Card (Government Entity issued)

If the picture identification does not contain a signature, you will be asked to provide an additional identification with your signature. If you do not have the proper identification, you will be allowed to vote a provisional ballot.

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VOTE-BY-MAIL BALLOTS (formerly Absentee Voting Ballots):

A voter, or an immediate family member or legal guardian of a voter, may request an absentee ballot from the City Hall in person, by mail or by telephone. The person requesting an absentee ballot must disclose:

- The name of the voter for whom the ballot is being requested;
- The voter's address;
- The voter's date of birth;
- The voter's signature (if the request is written);
- The requestor's name;
- The requestor's address;
- The requestor's driver's license number, if available;
- The requestor's relationship to the voter; and,
- The requestor's signature (if the request is written)

A voter can also authorize in writing a designee to pick up a ballot for him/her but please contact the City Hall because there are other restrictions that apply to this type of request.
