

REPORT FOR: MAY 2004

PROJECT: State Funded Sewer System Improvements.

- Waiting for a meeting with BDI to confirm if spending can begin for construction and knowledge of 201 Plan.
- Discussing the purchase of property with several individuals and soil testing is being set up for these properties.
- 201 Plan has been submitted.
- The City is testing other properties; we are back to a .7 m.g.p. plant with 100% collection system replacement.

PROJECT: Stormwater Drainage 5th Street.

- This project is intended to address flood-prone conditions at the intersection of Old Bonifay Road and 5th Street.
- We are working towards acquiring FEMA funds to engineer and build out this project.
- 90% Completion Plans have been submitted to DEP.
- FEMA has awarded the city a \$30,000 contract to do a feasibility study for this project. This requires a 25% match.
- The City has some fairly good verbal assurance that we can make this project work. We will move forward.

PROJECT: South Boulevard, 4th and 5th Streets.

- Project has begun and is approximately 90% complete.

PROJECT: Water Well Improvements.

- This project is in the hands of the attorney.
- Mediation set for February 9.
- Mediation meeting was held – City and Brown Well agreed to move forward with project.
- Waiting on Brown to move on job site.
- Material has been ordered.

PROJECT: Emergency Well Grant. *No change since last report.*

- City has applied for an emergency grant for a new 600 gpm well to be located on old Roulhac School property.
- Land transfer is completed.
- Awaiting additional information.

PROJECT: New Water Tank.

- CDBG has been approved.
- Money is available.
- City has contract for engineering services in hand – this has been approved by the State.
- Work will begin in near future.
- Engineer has begun work on project.
- Should have bids in around mid April.

Work has begun on the new Welcome sign for the south side of town. Sign is completed except for lighting.
