- A. Call to Order.** The Tentative Millage and Budget Adoption Hearing was called to order by Mayor Andrews at 5:05 p.m.

- C. Agenda Items.**
 - 1. Approval of Resolution No. 20-27** – Tentatively Adopt the Final Millage Rate for Fiscal Year 2020-2021. Mr. Miner read Resolution No. 20-27 by title:

RESOLUTION NO. 20-27

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHIPLEY OF WASHINGTON COUNTY, FLORIDA, ADOPTING THE FINAL MILLAGE RATE FOR FISCAL YEAR 2020-2021; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

The following was also read:

The gross taxable value for operating purposes not exempt from taxation within Washington County has been certified by the County Property Appraiser to the City of Chipley as \$149,154,721.

The Fiscal Year 2020-2021 operating millage rate is 7.0000 mills which is more than the rolled-back rate of 6.7290 mills by 4.03%.

A motion was made by Council Member Sasser and seconded by Council Member Cain to approve Resolution No. 20-27. The motion passed unanimously.

- 2. Approval of Resolution No. 20-28 – Tentatively Adopt the Final Budget for Fiscal Year 2020-2021. Mr. Miner read Resolution No. 20-28 by title:**

The City of Chipley of Washington County, Florida set forth appropriations and revenue estimates for the budget for Fiscal Year 2020-2021 in the amount of \$9,848,667.
