- A. Call to Order.** The meeting was called to order by Mayor Andrews at 5:15 p.m.
- B. Prayer and Pledge.** Prayer was given by Mayor Andrews and Mayor Andrews led the pledge to the American Flag.
- C. Agenda Items.**
- 1. Approval of Solid Waste Disposal Agreement – Springhill Regional Landfill.** Mr. Miner explained approval of this agreement will allow the city the ability to continue providing the limb and leaf pickup service to the citizens of Chipley. We are currently paying a rate of \$65 to \$75 per ton to haul limb and leaf debris to the landfill and this agreement will approve a rate of \$45 per ton when hauling limb and leaf debris to the landfill. This is the cheapest method we have been able to come up with and although we have an uncertainty of the amount of debris we will collect, the Public Works Director has done a good job coming up with what we think is a good estimate for budgeting purposes. Mr. Ronnie Bell with Waste Management explained the term of this agreement shall begin on October 1, 2020 and will expire on September 30, 2023 and the rate will be \$45 per ton. Mr. Sasser asked if we are talking about limb, leaf and yard debris pickup for the city or does this also include contractors doing work in the city. Mr. Miner stated this only includes the city because our code requires construction contractors to get their own containers and they are responsible for their own debris pickup/haul off. Mrs. Cain asked if we will continue to have our Amnesty pickup and Mr. Miner stated yes we will. Discussion ensued.

A motion was made by Council Member Cain and seconded by Council Member Sasser to approve the Solid Waste Disposal Agreement with Springhill Regional Landfill. The motion passed unanimously.

Mayor Andrews adjourned the meeting at 5:26 p.m.
